#### 1. <u>Permit Status Report:</u> No New Permits

\*Greene's permit expired but the owners have resubmitted the necessary paperwork to have it reissued.

All have paid their permit fee of \$1,500.00 and have received a Letter of Acceptance from the District for the county permit staff.

## 2. Monthly Road Evaluations:

Pothole repair project is under construction. The contractor is currently waiting for the correct oil to complete the repair and chip seal the hill on Impala.

\*It is the practice of the Board to form teams who annually conduct field surveys of the entire road system, including culverts and drainage ways within the CSD service area, followed by discussion and prioritization of repairs and/or improvements based on available funds. This process starts in October of each year with the objective of "short listing" proposed projects by the following January through March, weather permitting. After the surveys are complete, the teams compare notes and provide a proposed work schedule based on preliminary budget estimates and the combined results of the road surveys.

# 3. Sign Installation Project:

GM got a second bid for the sign installation project but it came in about the same as MTM's bid from last month. The board members are still debating on how to move forward with getting the signs installed for a reasonable cost. There are 32 signs to be installed throughout the district.

## **BOD Comments**

There is a need to address the curve near 5675 Ground Squirrel Hollow where there tends to be a lot of run off and puddling during heavy rain.

## **Adjournment**

A motion was made to adjourn the regular meeting by Director McCamy, seconded by Director Martinson and passed by unanimous voice vote. The meeting was adjourned at 7:40 p.m.
