1. <u>Permit Status Report:</u> No New Permits

5895 Black Tail Pl was finalized and the permit fee was refunded.

All have paid their permit fee of \$1,500.00 and have received a Letter of Acceptance from the District for the county permit staff.

2. Monthly Road Evaluations:

Pothole repair project was awarded to Mitch Fredrick Paving and work will begin around 9/13/18 as long as weather permits. Work will begin on Impala, Mulberry and Blossom.

*It is the practice of the Board to form teams who annually conduct field surveys of the entire road system, including culverts and drainage ways within the CSD service area, followed by discussion and prioritization of repairs and/or improvements based on available funds. This process starts in October of each year with the objective of "short listing" proposed projects by the following January through March, weather permitting. After the surveys are complete, the teams compare notes and provide a proposed work schedule based on preliminary budget estimates and the combined results of the road surveys.

3. <u>Resolution 2018- Opposition Measure G</u>

At our last meeting we had a guest speaker who spoke about measure G and her opposition to the measure, she was encouraging the board as a whole to request a No vote. GM took the time to review the measure more thoroughly and wrote up a resolution. After much discussion with the board, it was decided to not take any action on the Resolution as a board.

4. Sign Installation Project:

Received a bid back from MTM Construction for installation of the signs throughout the district, his bid came back at \$8,084, that would include them providing the posts for the signs. The board did not take any action and will discuss further at the next meeting.

A motion was made to adjourn the regular meeting by Director Martinson, seconded by Director Simons and passed by unanimous voice vote.
